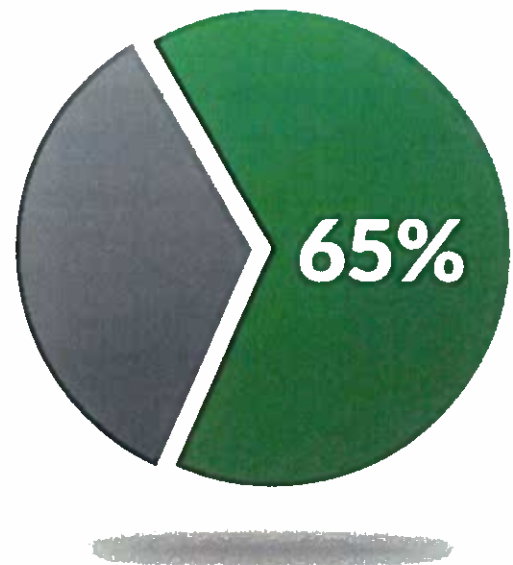

DOCUMENTATION REQUIRED FOR ELIGIBILITY

To determine if you are eligible for Workforce Solutions' specialized services and programs, you will be asked to submit several forms of documentation. If you have difficulties collecting any of the documents below, or if you have questions about the eligibility process, please refer to the reverse side of this flyer and contact the Workforce Solutions Career Center nearest you.

ONE document is needed from each category below to satisfy eligibility requirements. Place a check mark next to each category you are able to provide documentation from. All documents must be unexpired.

<p>Note: If providing pay stubs or bank records, proof of income for the past 6 months is required for applicant and all included family members. If you have not worked all of the previous 6 months, please bring whatever documentation you have available.</p>
